NON-ACCEPTABLE: Large Commercial/Industrial generators of HHW are not accepted.

- Households with more than 20 gallons or 20 lbs. must call the regional office at 860-536-6765.
- Latex Paint (dry out and dispose of in regular trash)
- Tires
- Ammunition/Gun Powder
- Auto or Marine Flares
- Radioactive Materials (smoke detectors, etc.)
